Subsidy Program



Three pricing tiers are available based on household income and available funding:

Subsidy Level	Small Entrée	Large Entrée	Eligibility
No Subsidy	\$5.75	\$6.75	Open to all families. Register at: https://simplyfoods.ahotlunch.ca/login
Partial Subsidy	\$3.50	\$4.50	\$2.25 discount per entrée. For households above low-income but below \$98,000 . Apply at: Subsidy Application
Full Subsidy	\$0	\$0	For families experiencing hardship or qualifying under low-income thresholds . Apply at: Subsidy Application

Statistics Canada Low Income Threshold

Eg: 5 people in family, making \$45,000 per year, apply for full subsidy

5 people in family, making above \$47,580 but below \$98,000, apply for partial subsidy
