Board Receives Secondary School Program Review Report

MISSION – The Mission School District Board of Trustees received the report of the Secondary School Program Review Committee at its regular Board Meeting held December 14, 2004. The report was commissioned by the Board to examine the district's secondary school program delivery and to make recommendations as to methods of enhancing student success and/or program effectiveness.

Last spring, parents, students, teachers and staff participated in forums designed to gather relevant information on the district's secondary schools. A total of six forums were held in April 2004 with more than 100 participants. Over the past several months the Secondary School Program Review Committee has spent considerable time reviewing and analyzing this information.

Upon receiving the final report, the Board acknowledged the effort and hard work of the committee. "We sincerely appreciate the time devoted by all committee members," said Board Chair Diane Kruger. "We look forward to reviewing it in more detail." The Board of Trustees intends to present the report at its February 2005 Board meeting.

School District No. 75 (Mission) serves the needs of approximately 7,000 students from Kindergarten to grade 12. The District employs more than 370 teachers and 150 school support staff in 3 high schools and 17 elementary schools throughout the district.
