Before the district course selection book describes the courses that are offered at our secondary school sites, we need to briefly explain ministry authorized and board/authority authorized courses. After these courses have been explained, this book will also review the courses students are required to take in their Grades 8 and 9 programs, as well as the required courses in Grades 10 to 12 that students need to graduate as outlined in the 2004 Graduation Requirements.

Ministry Authorized Courses

All three comprehensive secondary schools offer the required Ministry courses, (academic and electives) in their buildings. Ministry courses have curriculum (Integrated Resource Package, IRP) developed by the Ministry. All ministry courses have prescribed learning outcomes. Prescribed Learning Outcomes are the legally required content standards for the provincial education system. They define the required attitudes, skills, and knowledge for each course. For example, the learning outcomes are statements of what students are expected to know and be able to do by the end of the course.

Board/Authority Authorized (BAA) Elective Courses

As well as ministry authorized courses Mission Public Schools offers Board/Authority Authorized (BAA) courses. These elective courses have been developed by the teachers of Mission Public Schools for use in our schools and carry a value of four credits upon successful completion. Students are encouraged to select BAA or elective courses based upon their interests, abilities and future plans. Students may choose a variety of Ministry authorized courses and BAA courses to satisfy graduation requirements
