## **INTENSIVE CORE FRENCH INFORMATION NIGHT**

Intensive Core French is a second language teaching approach in which French is taught intensively for most of the day over five months throughout the Grade 6 year. The students in the program receive about 80% of their instruction in French during the first half of the year and 20% in French during the second half of the year. The remaining curricula (except for Mathematics) are “compressed” into the second half of the year. This optional program offers an alternative method of Core French Instruction for Grade 6 students.

This is not a French Immersion program but rather an alternative language acquisition program for those students interested in building their language skills more rapidly.
