1. A student using School District bus transportation must behave in a safe and orderly manner.
2. Students must obey the driver's directions at all times.
3. Students must remain in their seat while the bus is in motion.
4. Students must sit in the seat assigned by the driver.
5. Students must keep their heads and arms inside the bus at all times.
6. Throwing anything in the bus or out of the windows is forbidden.
7. Students must not talk to the driver while the bus is in motion.
8. Students must line up in a single file to enter the bus.
9. Students shall not move toward the bus until it stops. Only after the driver indicates that he/she is ready to have the bus loaded shall the students proceed to load the bus.
10. Students leaving the bus may cross the road in front of the bus if the vehicle is stationary and the RED LIGHTS ARE FLASHING.
11. Any willful damage and costs related to the repair of such damage to a bus by a student shall be the responsibility of the student and/or their parents/legal guardian.
12. Eating or drinking is not permitted on the bus.
13. Any objects deemed to pose a safety risk by School District staff are not allowed on the bus. (e.g. Sports equipment, Instruments, etc., must be contained within a seat in order to be permissible).
14. The District Code of Conduct (Policy #19) and Student Conduct Standards and Behaviour Management (Administrative Procedure #114) apply to all students while on the bus and at a bus stop. The policy and the procedure may be viewed at [www.mpsd.ca](http://www.mpsd.ca).
15. For the security of the students, surveillance cameras may be in operation at anytime.
16. Violation of any of these rules may result in the School District revoking the student's access to School District transportation services.
