Title:	Alcohol Consumption at School District Activities

It is the Board of Education's expectation that there be no consumption, sale or fundraising activity involving the sale of alcohol at any school district sponsored activity.

It is expected that principals will communicate to their students, parents and staff that alcohol must not be present at any school district sanctioned function.

If a parent, staff, PAC or community group wish to have alcohol present, then the principal must disassociate the activity from the school district in accordance with the [Schools Protection Program: Liability Insurance Coverage Administrative Procedure](#).

The organizers should be advised in writing that the activity will no longer be considered a school district activity and that the activity and volunteers or individuals sponsoring the activity will not be covered under the Schools Protection Program liability insurance coverage.

These guidelines will apply to all school district activities regardless of whether it is an adult's only activity.
