The Board of Education recognizes that all students who are of school age and who reside in Mission are entitled to a basic education which is free of charge. The Board of Education must approve annually all supply lists and fees set by schools to cover costs which exceed basic curriculum requirements. In addition, fees throughout the School District will reviewed annually to determine that they are consistent with each other and are in accordance with the *Ministerial School Board Fees Order*.

The Board of Education recognizes that no student shall be denied participation in any activities due to economic hardship. In such cases, schools will work with students on an individual basis.
