Title:	District Parent Advisory Council

The Board of Education supports the establishment of a District Parent Advisory Council to participate in an advisory role in contributing to the betterment of education in this district.

The District's Parent Advisory Council membership should be comprised of persons representing school Parent Advisory Councils within the Mission school district.

The District's Parent Advisory Council, through its elected officers, act as the official voice for parents at the district level, ensuring their perspectives are considered in educational matters. The District's Parent Advisory Council may advise the board and the superintendent of schools respecting any matter relating to district programs and services.

The District's Parent Advisory Council should develop a constitution and bylaws governing its meetings and the business conduct of its affairs.

The constitution and bylaws should be provided to the Board of Education.
