

International Student Program

The Board of Education, through its International Student Program, welcomes non-Canadian students to the school district and will establish procedures for admission to its schools.

All students seeking to enroll in a school must have their age and citizenship status verified before admission is authorized.

All non-Canadian students new to the school district must register at the District International Student Education office.

All letters to Canada Immigration on behalf of individual students will be processed through the District International Student Education office.

All non-Canadian students seeking to enroll in a Mission school must apply in accordance with the guidelines established by the District International Student Education office.
