

Habitat for Humanity Outreach to Mission Families

To Whom It May Concern,

My name is Lynne Stanger, and I am the new Director of Family Services at Habitat for Humanity Greater Vancouver. As you may already know, we are building a townhouse complex at 32588 Cedar Valley Connector.

The first phase has been completed and 8 families have moved in. The second phase with 12 homes has started and is expected to be completed by July 2022. We are in the final stages of accepting applications and selecting families for these homes and would really like to see more applications from families that currently live in or near the Mission area.

The units are 3 bedrooms, approximately 1800 square feet and geared for young families with at least one parent working full-time and earning in the range of \$38-78,000 annually. Families pay monthly housing payments that are calculated at 30% of their gross income, and when a family moves out of their Habitat home, they take a large portion of these payments with them as equity to use towards the purchase of a home.

So, if you know of any families that would meet these criteria and would be interested in one of our homes, I would be grateful if you shared my email with them and encouraged them to reach out to me directly.

I would be happy to join a virtual or in person District PAC event too.
