  - i) E. S. Richards is an Arts Based Curriculum School
- b) Looking for direction and guidance

  - ii) The group was humbled to see how many people were wearing orange shirts and recognizing the day, want to know and learn more
  - iii) Is there a way to consider a "Healing Through Arts" proposal we could present for this conference next year?

#### 6) Financial Statement Review - Vivian

- a) Vivian to consult with Derek Welsh (Asst Secretary-Treasurer):
  - i) Increase the funds for the Telephone
  - ii) Supplies Carryover (currently a negative balance of \$-13, 971.00)
  - iii) Will report back at the next meeting
- b) Grant Selection is tomorrow next month the Financial Statement will show school allocations
- c) If students need food or supplies, where do the funds come from? From school's funds (Community Links funding) and from Indigenous targeted School-Based Funding allotments
- d) Goal is a unified approach so students receive support from school and SWSW
- e) Do students get a textbook refund when they graduate? Vivian will look into this and report back at next meeting

## 7) 1701 Update - Vivian

- a) We currently have approxaimtely 1,130 students who self-identify as Indigenous
  - i) We have approximately 100 Nominal Roll students within the 1,130 (10% are Nominal Roll)

## 8) Indigenous Student Transition Teacher - Vivian

- a) Addressing Student Learning Concerns Fund: Senior Management met to discuss gaps
  - i) Presented to Members of the Board
  - ii) Approval of a .4 Teaching Position (2 days per/week) for an Indigenous Student Transition Teacher
    - (1) To work along with classroom teachers/course teachers for the following students
      - (a) Previous Band Outreach School students
      - (b) Indigenous Students attending on a limited basis
      - (c) Indigenous Students who received education via 'Storefront' program
      - (d) Support transitions back into school
      - (e) Were allotted an additional .2 FTE from BCTF (to compensate for Peggy's absences due to her work with the BCTF)
      - (f) Total .6 Indigenous Student Transition Teacher schedule Will be on Tuesdays, Wednesdays & Thursdays
      - (g) Vivian will report back at next meeting
- b) This will be for students mainly at Deroche, HMS & MSS

# 9) COVID Updates - Vivian

- a) Vivian shares regular COVID updates with SWSW Advisory (information Supt Wilson shares with All Staff and SD75 school community)
- b) Potential lockdown on Reserve due to COVID
  - a. Would like your feedback
  - b. If lockdown does happen, it would be helpful if both Leq'á:mel & Sq'éwlets would be on the same day
  - c. Vivian will report back at next meeting for potential plan

# 10) Equity Scan Update - Vivian

- a) For the past two years, we have been laying the foundations for Equity in SD75
- b) Now that we have the foundation, Equity is a common language among many SD75 staff
- c) Learning Series Equity Centred Trauma Informed Education by Alex Shevrin Venet
  - i) Dates: Nov 4, 2021; Jan 13, 2022; March 10, 2022, April 21, 2022, June 9, 2022 from 330-530pm
  - ii) Approx 25 people interested so far (Education Coordinators from Nations; SD75 Staff Admin, Student Services Staff, SWSW Staff etc)
- d) Len Pierre Mental Health Consulting
  - i) Vivian has a scheduled meeting with him to discuss possibilities for Mental Health training from Indigenous perspective, cultural humility and relevancy training – Vivian will report back at next meeting
- e) November 1<sup>st</sup> All SD75 staff to receive training on Racial Equity
- f) SD75 Policies Review: Vivian is working with Corien Becker to review a number of policies Vivian to report back at next meeting
