 - Two TERM staff on leave (until June 30, 2022 and June 2023, respectively)
 - One TERM staff on extended leave
 - One TEMPORARY staff on extended leave, contract runs out on June 30, 2022; will be unable to renew for 2022-2023

CURRENT:

- 13 fulltime TERM 35 hours per week ILW's
- One TERM staff on leave for part of the school year (Halq'emeylem instructor); unclear if this person will be returning
- One ILW TERM 28 hours per week (Halq'emeylem instructor); will be retiring in June 2022
- One ILW TERM 30 hours per week (currently on leave, working partial weeks; 21 hours per week)
- Three fulltime TEMP 35 hours per week ILWs
- One 21 hour per week TEMP ILW

Total ILW staff: 20 ILW (one ILW resigned recently, so for most of the 2021 2023 school year, we were at 21 ILWs

We are potentially looking to increase SWSW staff for a total of 22 for 2022 2023 school year.

- v) Still looking for a full time Indigenous Outreach teacher
